

Please find a copy of the revised EAP Supplements and Supplement Instructions for the June 2013 release. These supplement updates are scheduled to be implemented to align with the recently updated Integrated Standards and Guidelines document released in April 2013 and some consistency issues raised by stakeholders and ESRD Area offices. Please take the time to review these documents prior to the implementation date which has been pushed to June 7. The forms attached are visual representations of the final forms. Currently we are finalizing our system testing on the filable forms and their internal logic. Once completed, ESRD will post the working filable PDF forms on the ESRD external website. No changes have occurred to the MS-001 Mitigation Supplement.

As of June 7th, EDS will then only accept the June 1st versions of the Site and Installations, Access and Pipeline supplements for all EAP applications. Use of previous versions will result in the application being rejected. Please ensure you use the updated forms.

IN REVIEW, SUPPLEMENT FORM CHANGES CONSIST OF:

- Some prior content has been removed from the supplements for consistency and clarity around form completion,
- Purpose codes have been added to the Sites and Installations supplement to better guide applicant around applicable questions within the supplement form,
- Part D: Source of Water - was removed from the Sites and Installations Supplement,
- Added within the Pipeline supplement the ability to identify if a project is a multi-pipe project,
- Updated Site Sensitivity section to align with updated standards and conditions,
- The Reservation/Notation section of the forms has been reformatted to provide clarity to the applicants and rigor around the proper review of reservation/notations and higher level plans that interact with proposed activities,
