

British Columbia Government News Update – December 3, 2009

Effective immediately, Split Lease Submissions have been removed from ePayments.

This means Clients will continue to accompany a written application to split a lease or split transfer with a manual cheque.

We do not anticipate reviewing the option of introducing split submissions back into ePayments in the near future.

The Training Material, Online Tutorials, User Manual and Admin Cheat Sheet have all been updated to reflect this change.
