Richard Kruger, Chairman, President & CEO of Imperial Oil Limited

Topic: Global Energy Landscape, Canada's Opportunities and Challenges.

Rich Kruger was appointed Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of Imperial on March 1, 2013.

Mr. Kruger started his career with ExxonMobil in 1981 in Houston, Texas, and held various technical, supervisory, and management positions throughout the United States.

Over the last 35 years, he has led projects around the world in a number of countries and regions, including Malaysia, Africa, the Middle East and the former Soviet Union.

In 2005, Mr. Kruger was appointed Vice President, United States, ExxonMobil Production Company and in 2006 he was named executive Vice President of ExxonMobil Production Company. Two years later, he was appointed President of ExxonMobil Production Company and elected a vice president of Exxon Mobil Corporation.

A native to Minneapolis, Minnesota, Mr. Kruger holds a mechanical engineering degree from the University of Minnesota and a master's degree in business administration from the University of Houston.

Mr. Kruger is a member of the Business Council of Canada and co-chair of the C.D. Howe Institute's Energy Policy Council. He is also a long-standing supporter of the United Way, having served as a director of the United Way of Calgary and Area for a number of years and as a co-chair of the 2017 Calgary-wide campaign.
